SN	Criteria	1	1.5	2
	<u>PREPARATION</u>			
1.	Prepares all equipment needed: delivery set, drugs and material for receiving baby.			
2.	Places mother in a safe and comfortable position and explains about pushing and proper breathing.			
3.	Prepare self: puts on plastic apron, scrubs hands and puts on gloves at correct time (when head is at perineum).			
	<u>OBSERVATIONS DURING SECOND STAGE</u>			
4.	Listens and records fetal heart rate frequently after contractions (or asks assistant to do so).			
5.	Assesses progress of labour by observing the descent and advance of the presenting part with contractions.			
	<u>CONDUCTING THE DELIVERY</u>			
6.	Opens the delivery sets, clean the vulva area and drapes patient with sterile drape (if possible) using proper aseptic technique.			
7.	Respect dignity and the value of the mother preserving her rights of information before procedure.			

8.	Checks for full bladder and takes appropriate action and Encourages mother to push with each contraction.			
9.	Guards the perineum, and if necessary performs an episiotomy at correct time.			
10.	Controls delivery of head, tells mother to pant as head is crowning and delivers head by controlled extension.			
11.	Clears baby's airway by swabbing mouth and nose.			
12.	Checks for cord around neck <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If tight clamp and cut • If loose slip over the head 			
13.	Allows restitution and external rotation of the head.			
14.	Delivers first the anterior shoulder then the posterior shoulder and the rest of the body by lateral flexion.			
15.	Takes all precautionary measures to prevent post partum hemorrhage, including giving Oxytocic drug.			
16.	Notes the APGAR SCORE, while establishing respiration.			
17.	Keeps baby skin to skin contact with mother and wraps both mother and baby with warm cloth covering baby's head, put identification tag and breast feed immediately.			
18.	Delivers placenta by Controlled cord traction.			
19.	Massages the uterus immediately after delivery of placenta to prevent post partum hemorrhage.			
20.	Asks the assistant to check mother's vital signs.			
21.	Checks placenta and membranes for completeness.			
22.	Checks perineum and vulva for tear and if any tear or episiotomy is present repair as soon as possible under supervision of seniors.			
23.	Checks mother's fundus making sure it is contracted.			
24.	Clean vulva area, puts on clean pad and leaves mother comfortable.			
25.	Measures the blood loss and dispose the placenta safely.			
26.	Soaks the instruments in chlorine solution for decontamination and disposes used cotton, gauze and needles safely.			

27.	Provides mother hot drink.			
28.	Records all relevant information in mother's note and confinement book (delivery register).			
29.	Provides forth stage care to mother and baby.			
30.	Cleans all equipment, returns to proper place, and cleans and prepares delivery area for next client.

MANAGEMENT OF THE LABOUR ROOM				
1.	Keeps the labor room clean and tidy.			
2.	Ensure that sufficient materials, including drugs are available for the shifts.			
3.	Checks that all equipment is working properly, taking appropriate action to get repairs done if necessary.			
4.	Makes sure all instruments and materials are ready for emergency procedures.			
5.	Arrange the room to provide a comfortable and safe environment for mother			
6.	Receives mother and visitors courteously and warmly.			
7.	Takes complete history regarding pregnancy and labor from patient, family charts and other sources, and records accurately.			
8.	Assesses the mother abdominally vaginally to find out stage of labour.			
CARE DURING FIRST STAGE OF LABOUR				
9.	Accurately observe and records the mother's condition (temperature, pulse, blood pressure, breath, strength, frequency of contractions) and fetal condition (fetal heart rate) using partograph (keeps good record of partograph of minimum of 2 cases).			
10.	Encourage mother to take plenty of fluids and quick energy nutrients if permitted.			
11.	Encourages mother to empty bladder regularly.			
12.	Recognizes if findings are normal or abnormal, and take appropriate action.			

13.	Explains progress of labor to the patient and her family in order to give psychological support and obtain their cooperation.			
14.	Keeps patient clean and comfortable.			
15.	Teaches patient how to breathe and relax with contractions.			
16.	Teaches patient about pushing and prevents her from pushing before cervix is fully dilated.			
17.	Knows when to call doctor, and is able to state reason why Doctor is being called.			
18.	Recognizes signs of second stage of labor.			
DUTIES OF THE CIRCULATING NURSE IN THE DELIVERY ROOM				
19	Places the mother in a safe and comfortable position for delivery, and guides her to push with contractions.			
20.	Assesses progress of labor by observing the descent and advance of the presenting part with contractions. .			
21	Listens to and records fetal heart rate frequently after contractions			
22.	Meets the needs of the scrub nurse in order to accomplish smooth and successful normal delivery.			
23.	Receives the newborn baby, clears the air way and gives any resuscitation needed.			
24	Collaborates with other health team members in the provision of total care.			
25.	Works with the scrub nurse to clean and prepare the delivery area for the next patient.
